

Ilex verticillata 'Red Sprite'



Cornus alternifolia (Pagoda Dogwood). Zone 3. Grows 20-25' high and wide. 30-year lifespan. Small, compact, deciduous, slow-growing tree. Hardy substitute for the refined Cornus florida. Features four-season interest: fragrant, creamy-white flowers in flat clusters held above the leaves in May-June; bird-attracting, showy, dark blue berries in mid summer; dark green leaves that turn a rich burgundy/purple color in the fall; and horizontal branches that outline snow in winter. Low canopy and growth as an understory plant in northeastern forests make it an ideal companion with other trees and shrubs away from competing grass. Prefers full sun with partial shade from hot afternoon sun. Prefers moist and richly organic, acidic soil; doesn't tolerate drought, standing water, or urban pollution. In very cold or exposed locations, shallow roots welcome mulch over root zone in winter. Low maintenance; best without pruning.





Hydrangea paniculata 'Little Quick Fire.' Zone 3. Grows 3-5' high and 2-4' wide.

Compact, rounded, deciduous shrub with multi-season interest. Red stems. Showy, long-lasting, creamy-white, cone-shaped blooms turn deep pink with red highlights in summer. Blooms before other hydrangeas throughout early to late summer. Attracts pollinators. Upright habit. Good in mixed border or as specimen or foundation plant. Part sun to sun. Drought tolerant, but should mulch to conserve moisture. Easy maintenance. Blooms on new wood, so trim in late winter or early spring. Apply slow-release fertilizer in spring. Adaptable to soil and tolerant of air-pollution.



Aronia melanocarpa 'Low Scape Mound.' Zone 3. Grows 1-2' high and 2' wide.

Dwarf, compact, native, deciduous shrub with multi-season interest. Masses of white flowers in spring; black fruits in summer; glossy green foliage turns orange-red in fall. Adaptable, but prefers averagemedium moisture and well-drained soils. Drought and salt tolerant, deer resistant. Sun to part shade. Edible berries sweeten after a freeze. Low maintenance. Blooms on old wood. Attracts pollinators and birds. Good for mixed border, mass planting, erosion control. 2019 Landscape Shrub of the Year.
