Canopy Management Plan: The 2 dead trees on the green in the Depot have been removed. The plantings have been completed at the Pinnacle and Hardware Store and the Elm on the Green is being straightened.

Wayfinding Plan: The draft Wayfinding Plan has been sent to VTrans for review and comment.

Depot Street: There is a meeting scheduled with the rail regarding the pedestrian crossing. Preliminary plans will begin soon.

Church Street: A grant has been received to conduct a Scoping Study on Church Street for a new sidewalk/walking path.

Tomasso Land: There will be a community meeting on September 20 to learn about what a community forest is.

Zoning Rewrite: Brandy Sexton has been hired to do the work for the zoning rewrite. The Planning Commission will meet on September 13 to review the zoning districts & Map. It is anticipated that the first draft will be reviewed in early December.

New Grant Opportunities include a housing study and stabilization of Yosemite.

3. Discussion Regarding Potential Events:

The committee discussed enhancing some events that already exist in town such as the winter carnival and the fireworks. Ideas brought forth include a snow sculpture competition at the Legion field for winter carnival.
